



## **Iron Mountain-Kingsford Rotary Club Scholarship Criteria**

### **Dickinson Area Community Foundation**

*On May 18, 1971, a Trust was established and named the “Iron Mountain Rotary Club Scholarship”. A worthy graduate of Iron Mountain or Kingsford High School was chosen as the recipient yearly. Beginning in 1986, the Rotary Club Scholarship was awarded every year to a worthy graduate from each school.*

*Presently, the Iron Mountain-Kingsford Rotary Club Scholarship is overseen by the Dickinson Area Community Foundation. Up to two worthy students from Iron Mountain High School and two worthy students from Kingsford High School are selected by the Rotarians each year to receive the scholarship.*

#### **Eligibility:**

1. The applicant must be a graduating Iron Mountain or Kingsford High School Senior.
2. The person chosen must come from a family of modest means in need of financial assistance and the person chosen must have a sincere desire to attend a college or university.
3. Applicants must include a paragraph (approx. 150-250 words) on the reason they are applying for this scholarship. The applicant should write about their plans, financial need, their philosophy of life, any extenuating circumstances in their home, and why they want education beyond high school.
4. The student must provide two personal reference letters, one from a teacher and one from a person other than a teacher who is familiar with the student (cannot be a family member).
5. The student must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0.
6. A transcript of the student’s high school records must be included with the application.
7. All completed scholarship application forms and parent information forms must be returned to the Guidance Office by **March 15th**. Failure to turn in the completed application by the due date will result in the student being ineligible to apply for this scholarship.
8. The scholarship may be a one-time award or a renewable award. Renewable scholarship awards shall be disbursed in two equal payments over a two-year period, provided the recipient remains eligible to receive the award. To remain eligible, the recipient must be a full-time student (12 or more credit hours per semester or the equivalent) and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50. The recipient must submit their official college transcript to Dickinson Area Community Foundation (DACF) after completing Spring semester to confirm eligibility prior to award disbursement.
9. A scholarship award may be revoked by the DACF Board of Trustees because of:
  - a. Criminal or anti-social conduct of recipient.
  - b. Filing false information on application.
  - c. Scholastic inadequacy of a recipient.
  - d. For such other good cause as the Board may, in its sole discretion, determine.

Revocation shall be by the action of a majority of the members of the Board of Trustees, and upon such revocation, any and all funds still controlled by the Board of Trustees shall be withheld and disposed of at the discretion of the Board.
