

Clara Dierickx Scholarship Criteria

Norway Area Community Foundation an affiliate of the Dickinson Area Community Foundation

This scholarship is named in honor of Clara Dierickx, who served the Norway-Vulcan Area Schools for forty-one years as a teacher and principal at the elementary level.

One scholarship recipient will be chosen annually from Norway High School. The recipient shall receive a one-time scholarship award in an amount to be determined annually based upon earned income of the fund.

Eligibility:

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Norway High School who intends to attend an institution of higher learning to pursue an elementary teaching degree.
- 2. The selection is to be based on character, personality, scholarship, and an interest in elementary teaching.
- 3. The scholarship is a one-time award and is not renewable.
- 4. Applicants must submit an essay of 200-250 words in their own handwriting. The essay must demonstrate the applicant's distinctive individual qualities and how they will help the applicant become an effective elementary teacher.
- 5. Financial need will not be a factor in the selection of the recipient.
- 6. All applicants must adhere to Guidance Counselor deadlines. Failure to turn in a completed application by the due date will result in the student being ineligible to apply for this scholarship. Guidance Counselors, all completed applications must be returned to Dickinson Area Community Foundation by March 15.
- 7. The scholarship committee will be compromised of the following:
 - a. Superintendent of Schools
 - b. High School Principal
 - c. Elementary Principal
 - d. High School Guidance Counselor
